# Distance Education Enrollments at Illinois Colleges and Universities

Data for Spring 2014

### **Executive Summary**

Illinois colleges and universities reported a total of 248,833 enrollments in online and blended courses during the Spring 2014 term. Enrollments in all distance education courses totaled 255,161 for Spring term. After a small decline for Spring semesters (2012 and 2013), Spring 2014 showed an increase in online and blended courses and an overall 2% enrollment increase in all distance education courses.

#### **Online Courses and Enrollments**

Illinois colleges and universities reported **248,833** enrollments in online and blended courses during the Spring 2014 term. This is a **3%** increase in enrollments from Spring 2013 when there were **242,437** enrollments.

#### **Blended Courses**

We now ask for blended course enrollments from the 4-year institutions. This request for data shows **12,732** enrollments that account for **4.99%** of all enrollments for Spring 2014. The definition used for blended during this term is 25-75% at a distance.


#### Online Enrollments by Sector

Community colleges reported **97,442** enrollments in all distance education delivery modes which account for **38.19**% of enrollments for the Spring 2014 term. Community colleges now represent the largest percentage of enrollments by sector. Public universities accounted for **16.01**%, independent not-for-profit institutions provided **10.51**% and independent for-profit institutions provided **35.30**% of enrollments for Spring 2014 term.

#### **Enrollments in Online Courses**

This graph shows online course enrollments reported by Illinois colleges and universities for the Spring terms since Spring 2000.





## **Changes in Enrollment by Delivery Mode**

#### **Online Enrollment Percentage**

Online enrollments accounted for **92.53%** of all distance education enrollments in the Spring 2014 term with blended enrollments accounting for another **4.99%** for a total of **97.52%** of all enrollments.

#### **All Other Delivery Mode Percentage**

Enrollments in all other delivery modes except Stored Media decreased for the Spring 2014 term, although only **2.48%** of enrollments were in delivery modes other than online. Table 2 in the Appendix shows the change in distance education enrollments by delivery mode from Spring 2013 to Spring 2014.

## Online Enrollments by Sector

#### **Community College Enrollment**

During the Spring 2014 term community colleges reported **92,661** enrollments for **37.24%** of all online course enrollments.

#### **Public University Enrollment**

Public universities reported offering 39,803 enrollments for 16% of all online course enrollments.

#### **Independent For-Profit Colleges and Universities**

Independent for-profit colleges and universities reported offering **90,064** enrollments for **36.19%** of all online courseenrollments.

#### **Independent Not-For-Profit Colleges and Universities**

Independent not-for-profit colleges and universities reported **26,305** enrollments for **10.57%** of all online course enrollments.

#### **Institutions With the Largest Online Enrollments**


The Illinois institutions reporting the largest online course enrollments during the Spring 2014 term in each sector of higher education in Illinois were:

College of DuPage (10,423) and Joliet Junior College (5,471) from the community college system.

University of Illinois at Springfield (5,864) and University of Illinois at Chicago (5,328) from the public universities.

DeVry University (89,303) from the independent for-profit colleges and universities.

**DePaul University (7,236)** from the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities.

## Online Enrollments by Residency

The vast majority of all online course enrollments reported by Illinois public colleges and universities were from students residing in the state. Independent colleges and universities had a majority of online student course enrollments living in the USA, but outside of Illinois.

The residency of students enrolled in online courses varied by sector, with community colleges having the highest percentage of Illinois residents (96.3%), followed by the public universities (79.6%), and the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities (79.1%).

The State of Illinois greatly appreciates the cooperative effort of all Illinois colleges and universities and the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) in submitting the distance education course enrollment data for this report.
