Distance Education Enrollments at Illinois Colleges and Universities

Data for Summer 2019/Academic Year 2018-2019

Executive Summary

Illinois colleges and universities reported 840,964 enrollments in all distance education delivery modes during academic year 2018-2019. Of those enrollments, 81% (834,111) were in online or blended course sections. Stored Media courses are down significantly, while Interactive TV courses showed the largest increase from 2017-2018.

Online Courses and Enrollments


Illinois colleges and universities reported **204,773** enrollments during the Summer 2019 term. This is a 2.8% decrease from Summer 2018 term when there were **210,584** enrollments. The enrollments for Academic Year 2018-2019 for online and blended courses were **834,111**. This is a **0.5**% decrease from Academic Year 2017-2018 when there were **838,539** enrollments.

Blended Courses

This report includes blended course enrollments from all institutions. This request for data shows **14,558** enrollments that account for **7.07%** of all enrollments for Summer 2019. The definition used for blended during this term is 25-75% at a distance.

Enrollments in Online Courses

This graph shows online course enrollments reported by Illinois colleges and universities for the Summer terms from 2010 through 2019.



Changes in Enrollment by Delivery Mode

Online and Blended Enrollment Percentage

Online and blended enrollments accounted for **99.5%** of all distance education enrollments in the Summer 2019 term.

All Other Delivery Mode Percentage

The Summer 2019 term saw decreases in all delivery modes with online and blended courses and total enrollments decreasing **2.8% and 2.5%** respectively. The largest decrease was seen in Stored Media courses. Table 2 in the Appendix shows the change in distance education enrollments by delivery mode from Summer 2018 to Summer 2019.

Online Enrollments by Sector

Community College Enrollment

During the Summer 2019 term, community colleges reported **68,040** enrollments for **33.23%** of all online course enrollments.

Public University Enrollment

Public universities reported **55,431** enrollments for **27.07%** of all online course enrollments.

Independent For-Profit Colleges and Universities

Independent for-profit colleges and universities reported **62,792** enrollments for **30.66%** of all online course enrollments.


Independent Not-For-Profit Colleges and Universities

Independent not-for-profit colleges and universities reported **18,510** enrollments for **9.04%** of all online course enrollments.

Institutions With the Largest Online Enrollments

The Illinois institutions reporting the largest online course enrollments during the Summer 2019 term in each sector of higher education in Illinois were:

- College of DuPage (10,196) and Joliet Junior College (4,998) from the community college system.
- University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (15,858) and Illinois State University (8,350) from the public universities.
- DeVry University (62,792) from the independent for-profit colleges and universities.
- **DePaul University (5,664)** from the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities.

Online Enrollments by Residency

The vast majority of all online course enrollments reported by Illinois public colleges and universities were from students residing in the state. Independent colleges and universities had a majority of online course enrollments from students living in the U.S. outside of Illinois.


The residency of students enrolled in online courses varied by sector, with community colleges having the highest percentage of Illinois residents (96%), followed by independent not-for-profit colleges and universities (82%) and the public universities (76%).

Annual Academic Year Enrollments

Illinois colleges and universities reported a total of **834,111** online course enrollments and **840,964** total enrollments in all distance education during academic year 2018-2019 (Fall 2018, Spring 2019 and Summer 2019). This is an decrease of 4,468 online course enrollments **(0.5%)** and a decrease of 5,721 course enrollments **(0.67%)** in all distance education delivery modes from the previous academic year (2017-2018).
