Distance Education Enrollments at Illinois Colleges and Universities

Data for Fall 2020

Executive Summary

2020 distance education enrollments significantly impacted by higher education's response to COVID

For the Fall 2020 term, 1,208,998 course enrollments were reported in online and blended courses. This is a 258% increase from the 337,940 course enrollments reported in the Fall 2019 term. Online and blended enrollments accounted for 97.32% of all distance course enrollments in this unprecedented term.

Community colleges and public universities accounted for the largest percentages of online enrollments with 31.88% and 50.70% respectively, for a total of 82.58% or 998,345 of the over 1.2 million enrollments. Interactive TV delivery mode also saw a large increase during the COVID-19 pandemic, yet still only accounted for 2.68% of all distance education enrollments.

The data for Fall 2020 is illustrative of the flexibility and agility of Illinois colleges and universities in their response to the global pandemic in ensuring students maintained access to their courses. Illinois higher education institutions met the student need for online instruction with inventiveness, alacrity, and quality. The turn-around to new instructional platforms and the utilization of available technologies was unparalleled.

Distance Education Enrollments


Illinois colleges and universities reported **1,242,323** enrollments during the Fall 2020 term. This is an **263%** increase in enrollments from Fall 2019 when there were **341,650** enrollments in all distance education modality. Fall 2020 showed an 826% increase in Interactive TV courses with 33,237 enrollments compared to the 3,588 enrollments in this modality for Fall 2019.

Blended Courses

All Illinois institutions now provide data on blended courses. The **103,141** enrollments for Fall 2020 account for **8.3%** of all distance education enrollments. The **103,141** enrollments for Fall 2020 show a **107%** increase from the **49,644** enrollments for Fall 2019 in the blended modality. Blended and online enrollments accounted for **97.32%** of all distance education enrollments for Fall 2020.

Online Enrollments by Sector

Public universities account for the largest percentage of all online course enrollments at **50.70%** and **49.77%** of all distance education enrollments. Illinois community colleges are second largest with **31.88%** of online enrollments and **33.27%** of all distance education enrollments for Fall 2020. Independent for-profit colleges and universities account for the lowest percentages at **6.09%** and **5.93%** repectively. Comparatively for Fall 2019, the independent for-profit institutions represented **19.14%** of online course enrollments and **18.93%** of all distance educations enrollments.



Changes in Enrollment by Delivery Mode

Online Enrollment Percentage

Online enrollments accounted for **89.02%** of all distance education enrollments in the Fall 2020 term with blended enrollments accounting for another **8.30%** for a total of **97.32%** of all enrollments.

All Other Delivery Mode Percentage

Enrollments in all other delivery modes accounted for only **2.69%** of all enrollments in the Fall 2020 term. Table 2 in the Appendix shows the change in distance education enrollments by delivery mode from Fall 2019 through Fall 2020.

Online Enrollments by Sector

Community College Enrollment

During the Fall 2020 term, community colleges reported **385,429** enrollments for **31.88%** of all online course enrollments. **City Colleges of Chicago (57,430)** and **Harper College (32,961)** reported the largest enrollments from the community college system.

Public University Enrollment


Public universities reported **612,916** enrollments for **50.70%** of all online course enrollments. **University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (275,398)** and **Illinois State University (95,664)** reported the largest enrollments from the public universities.

Independent For-Profit Colleges and Universities

Independent for-profit colleges and universities reported **73,680** enrollments for **6.09%** of all online course enrollments. **DeVry University (73,680)** from the independent for-profit colleges and universities.

Independent Not-For-Profit Colleges and Universities

Independent not-for-profit colleges and universities reported **136,973** enrollments for **11.33%** of all online course enrollments. **DePaul University (75,130)** from the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities.



Online Enrollments by Residency

The vast majority of all online course enrollments reported by Illinois public colleges and universities were from students residing in the state. Independent colleges and universities had a majority of online course enrollments from students living in the USA but outside of Illinois.

The State of Illinois greatly appreciates the cooperative effort of all Illinois colleges and universities and the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) in submitting the distance education course enrollment data for this report.
