## Distance Education Enrollments at Illinois Colleges and Universities

Data for Summer 2020/Academic Year 2019-2020

#### **Executive Summary**

Illinois colleges and universities reported 998,304 enrollments in all distance education delivery modes during academic year 2019-2020. This is an increase of 19% from enrollments for the academic year 2018-2019. Online course enrollments from Summer 2019 to Summer 2020 increased 47% which indicates a COVID19 instruction increase in online course delivery.

#### **Online Courses and Enrollments**


Illinois colleges and universities reported **300,073 online** enrollments during the Summer 2020 term. This is a 46% increase from Summer 2019 term when there were **204,773** enrollments. The enrollments for Academic Year 2019-2020 for online and blended courses were **991,263**. This is a **19%** increase from Academic Year 2018-2019 when there were **834,111** enrollments.

#### **Blended Courses**

This report includes blended course enrollments from all institutions. This request for data shows **9,206** enrollments that account for **3.05**% of all enrollments for Summer 2020. This is a decrease from past terms with a nod to COVID19 courses being offered online versus blended.

#### **Enrollments in Online Courses**

This graph shows online course enrollments reported by Illinois colleges and universities for the Summer terms from 2010 through 2020.

#### **Changes in Enrollment by Delivery Mode**

#### **Online and Blended Enrollment Percentage**

Online and blended enrollments accounted for **99.57%** of all distance education enrollments in the Summer 2020 term.

#### **All Other Delivery Mode Percentage**

The Summer 2020 term saw increases in online and blended courses and interactive TV courses with enrollments increasing **47% and 33%** respectively. Stored Media and Correspondence enrollments both decreased from Summer 2019 to Summer 2020. Table 2 in the Appendix shows the change in distance education enrollments by delivery mode from Summer 2019 to Summer 2020.

#### **Online Enrollments by Sector**

#### **Community College Enrollment**

During the Summer 2020 term, community colleges reported **113,312** enrollments for **37.76%** of all online course enrollments.

#### **Public University Enrollment**

Public universities reported 91,306 enrollments for 30.43% of all online course enrollments.

#### **Independent For-Profit Colleges and Universities**

Independent for-profit colleges and universities reported **69,195** enrollments for **23.06%** of all online course enrollments.


#### **Independent Not-For-Profit Colleges and Universities**

Independent not-for-profit colleges and universities reported **26,260** enrollments for **8.75%** of all online course enrollments.

#### **Institutions With the Largest Online Enrollments**

The Illinois institutions reporting the largest online course enrollments during the Summer 2020 term in each sector of higher education in Illinois were:

- College of DuPage (20,589) and Harper College (10,987) from the community college system.
- University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (24,042) and Illinois State University (10,966) from the public universities.
- DeVry University (69,195) from the independent for-profit colleges and universities.
- DePaul University (12,997) from the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities.

#### **Online Enrollments by Residency**

The vast majority of all online course enrollments reported by Illinois public colleges and universities were from students residing in the state. Independent colleges and universities had a majority of online course enrollments from students living in the U.S. outside of Illinois.


The residency of students enrolled in online courses varied by sector, with community colleges having the highest percentage of Illinois residents (96%), followed by independent not-for-profit colleges and universities (82%) and the public universities (76%).

#### **Annual Academic Year Enrollments**

Illinois colleges and universities reported a total of **991,263** online course enrollments and **998,304** total enrollments in all distance education during academic year 2019-2020 (Fall 2019, Spring 2020 and Summer 2020). This is an increase of 157,152 online course enrollments **(19%)** and a increase of 157,340 course enrollments **(19%)** in all distance education delivery modes from the previous academic year (2018-2019).
